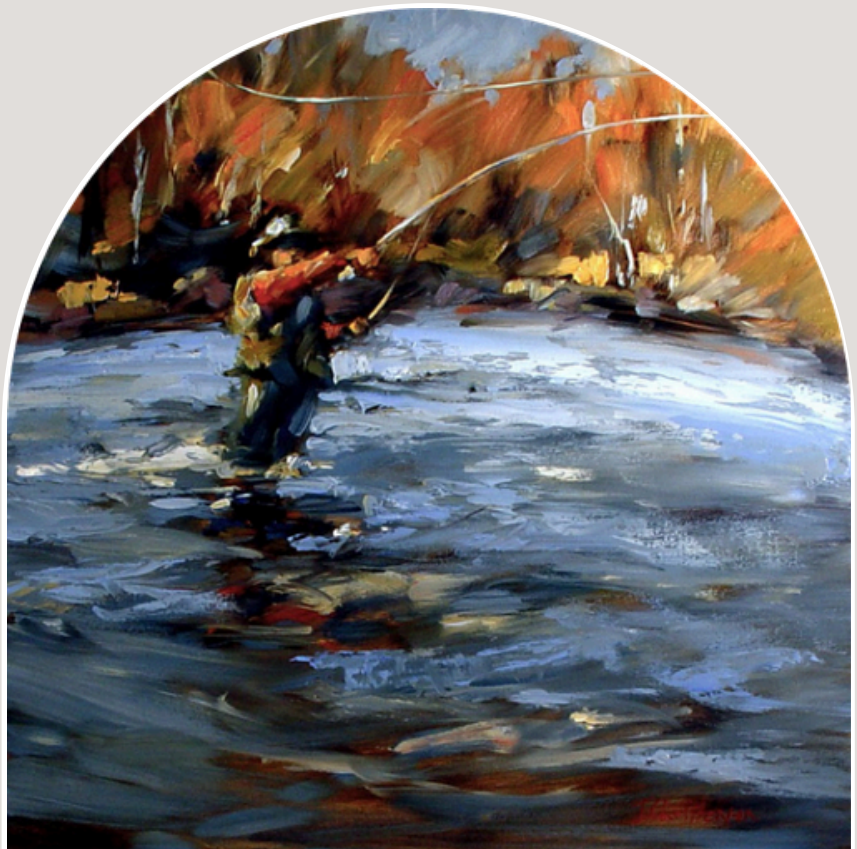

- Rain jacket and pants

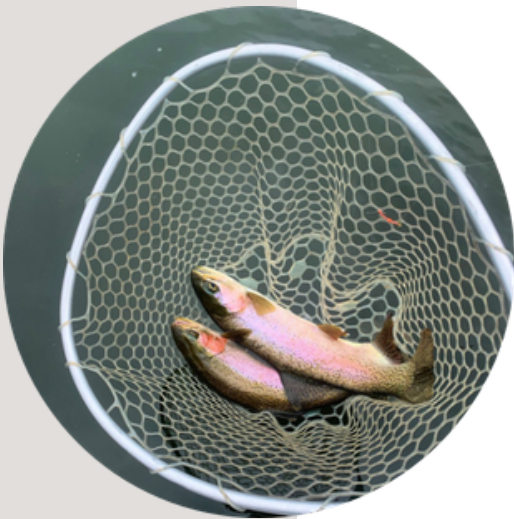


GEAR & APPAREL *cont'd*



All fishing gear including rods, reels, lines, tackle, waders, and boots may be provided by the Lodge and/or your Fishing Guide.

Traveling with your personal fly-fishing gear can be cumbersome and expensive.



As an Orvis endorsed lodge, we offer a complimentary fleet of Orvis and Simms gear for guests' use.



If you prefer to use your own gear, you are welcome to! We know what it's like to have a special rod and reel that you're just dying to get wet.

Recommendations for our guests bringing their own fly fishing gear

RODS

5 to 6 weight rods are best. 7 weight rods work great for streamers. Fast action rods work best for windy days.

REELS

Reels should be loaded with 100 yards of 20 lb. backing with a line matching the weight of your rod. Reels should have good drag systems for fighting our large browns and rainbows.

LINES

Lines should match the rod weight or be overloaded by one line weight for casting in the wind (i.e. #7WF for a #6 rod). We recommend weight forward floating lines. Dry line or clear tip for streamer fishing is best.

TACKLE

Fishing guides will provide leaders, tippetts, and flies for your convenience. If you want to try some of your own patterns, simply visit with your guide.

FISHING GUIDES



Our fishing guides are some of the best on the river with a combined years of experience exceeding the age of our most seasoned guests! Our guides are in high demand and book out quickly. If you have a guide preference, please make your request known at the time of booking or as soon as possible.

Based on scheduling and availability, you may not have the same guide for your entire stay.

FISHING LICENSES

To Do

We strongly recommend purchasing your fishing license prior to arrival. Fishing licenses may be purchased via [Montana FWP's Online Licensing](#). You will need to provide a copy of your license to your guide the first morning of fishing via photo of a fishing license on your phone and/or carry the paper copy.

- New license fees and information are available beginning every February 28th.
- For current pricing, please see [Montana FWP's Fishing License and Permit page](#).
- Licenses include a mandatory \$10 conservation license and Angler Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention Pass (AISPP) fee that is automatically added to your purchase.
- Children (ages 11 and under) are not required to purchase a license.



TRANSPORTATION

We understand making transportation arrangements to the Lodge will be an added step to coordinating travel plans. We recommend guests drive in via renting a car or scheduling a shuttle to the lodge.

- Helena: 45 minutes
- Bozeman: 2.5 hours
- Missoula: 2.5 hours
- Kalispell: 3.5 hours

RENTAL CARS

We strongly recommend reserving well in advance to ensure availability.

RIDE SHARE SERVICES

We do not recommend using Uber or Lyft as there is limited availability due to our remote rural location.

Check IN

- ✓ Check-in time is 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.
- ✓ If arriving outside this window, please notify management.
- ✓ If arriving at the Lodge before 1:00 pm, an additional half day of fishing may be available!

Check OUT

- ✓ Complete your financial check out with the manager by 5:30 pm the evening prior to departure. Checkout includes Pro Shop purchases, Lodge staff gratuities, etc.
- ✓ Checkout time is 10:00 a.m.
- ✓ Travel Safe!



GRATUITIES

The Lodge maintains a pooled tip policy for staff, please do not tip individually. Our team's combined efforts work toward making sure your stay is an experience to remember. The average tip is 8 – 15% of your total invoice. Gratuities are received from guests during the final checkout the evening before departure. Cash is preferred, but checks and credit cards are accepted.

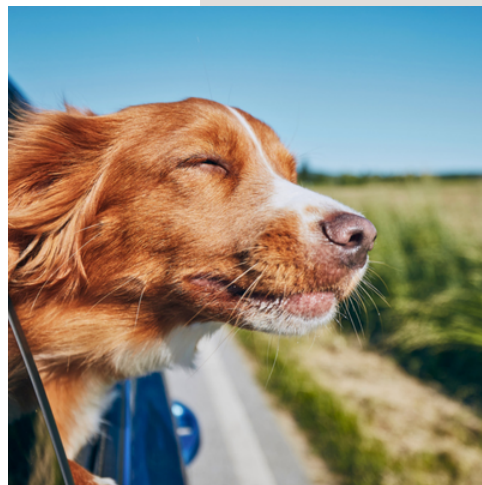
We suggest gratuities for your fishing guides be tipped to hand with cash or check after coming off the river each day as your guide may change from day to day. A standard guide tip is \$150-\$200 per boat (full day) or \$100-\$150 per boat (half day).

We recommend using these as guidelines, but to always tip what you feel is appropriate.

Pet Policy GUIDE

The Lodge has one pet friendly room available for guests traveling with a dog. It is available on a first come, first serve basis.

- Pet fee of \$150 per pet (two dogs max)
- Dogs are not allowed in Lodge common areas
- Dogs may not be left behind during the day
- Dogs must accompany you on outings or one of your party remain behind with your pet



Frequently Asked QUESTIONS

1. Daily Routine

The Lodge follows a fishing schedule taking cues from the river, weather, and time of year. Average Daily Routine:

Breakfast from 6 – 8 am

Departure between 7 – 9 am

Return time may be between 3 – 5 pm

Cocktail hour from 3 – 6 pm

Dinner service 6:30 pm

2. Laundry Services

Our team is available to do laundry for you. We recommend laundry the day before you depart. Please use the provided plastic laundry bag and leave on the foot of the bed.



Frequently Asked QUESTIONS

3. Inclement Weather

Undesirable fishing conditions are not acceptable reasons to cancel and receive a refund. In the event of dangerous conditions, the Lodge's endorsing outfitter reserves the right to cancel that day.

4. Meals

Breakfast is made to order every morning. Lunch, snacks, appetizers, and dinner is the same for all guests. For dietary restrictions, allergies, or preferences, please be sure to complete our [Guest Preference Form](#) at least 30 days prior to arrival.



Frequently Asked QUESTIONS

5. Wine & Spirits

The Lodge offers a complimentary bar including a collection of house wines, domestic beers, local microbrews on tap, and some top shelf spirits to mix up your favorite cocktail.

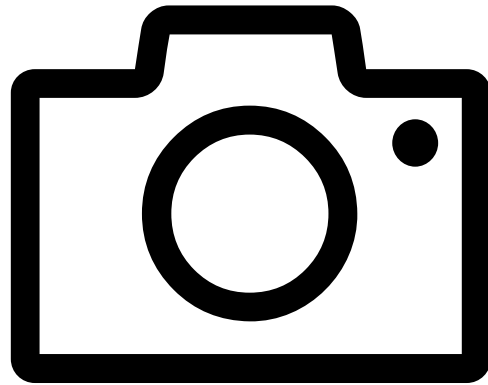
